ATTENTION:

From February 22, 2021 in the Czech Republic:

It is mandatory to wear **FFP2 respirators without vents** or **other respiratory protection** of similar quality (nano-mask) in **all public interior spaces** (shops, services, medical and social care centers, public transport and public transport stops and stations, airports, inside vehicles etc.) and also **outdoor areas** where 2 or more people come in within 2 meters distance of each other (not including family members).

Cloth face masks are no longer considered as appropriate protection!

1. WHAT RESTRICTIONS APPLY TO YOU?

According to the latest measurements announced by the Czech Government and with **effect from March 1st, 2021**, all countries are divided into 5 categories based on risk of Covid-19 transmission. Every category has specific pre-arrival and after-arrival duties.

Dark Red = Very High-Risk Countries – are considered all countries that are excluded from the list above and all third countries that are not marked as green

Rules for entry and return to the Czechia (as of 5th February 2021)

There are exceptions from these rules, particularly for the international transport and regular cross-border movement (cross-border workers, pupils and students, persons having rights of custody or rights of visitation).

¹ PES - anti-epidemic system of the Czech Republic

Green country - country with a low risk of COVID-19 transmission
Orange country - country with a medium risk of COVID-19 transmission
Red country - country with a high risk of COVID-19 transmission
Dark red country - country with a very high risk of COVID-19 transmission

Country that is not on the list of countries is considered as a country with a very high risk of COVID-19 transmission.



ATTENTION: It is not possible to travel to the countries with an extreme risk of COVID-19 transmission. List of countries with an extreme risk is available on the website of the Ministry of Health.

ATTENTION:

- Students and employees must inform their school and/or employer when travelling to any other than a green country for more than 12 hours.
- Students and employees must present a negative test result to school and/or employer on arrival to the Czech Republic from (in accordance with regulations).

2. MANDATORY PRE-ARRIVAL FORM AND TESTING FOR COVID-19

Students who spent **more than 12 hours in any country other than green/low risk in the last 14 days** are obliged to fill in an **online form** prior to arrival and undergo a **test** for COVID-19 **prior to their arrival to the Czech Republic**. Travelers from **Red** and **Dark Red** countries are also required to undergo a **PCR test in CR**. In particular, they have to:

1. **Fill in an online form** <https://plf.uzis.cz/> and save the confirmation you have done so as it may be requested at border control
2. **Get tested before departure for CR and have a written confirmation of this to show at the border/Prague Airport control:**
 - **Orange & Red countries** – Antigen (max 24h before arrival) or RT-PCR test (max 72h before arrival)
 - **Dark Red countries** – RT-PCR test (max 72h before arrival)

3. Self-isolation and a RT-PCR test after arrival to the Czech Republic:

- **Red countries** – must undergo test within 5 days of arrival
- **Dark Red countries** must undergo test no sooner than 5 days after arrival
- Everyone has to **self-isolate and limit their movements** to obtaining essentials only – **wearing FFP2 respirator (mandatory!) when outside of your residence**

4. Send the RT-PCR test results to your local Hygiene Station (covid-hc@hygpraha.cz)

Please inform also UNYP at rectoroffice@unyp.cz !

Your email to the Hygiene Station must include:

1. Your name and surname
2. Date of birth
3. Your address (in Prague)
4. Phone number (Czech)
5. Date of arrival to the Czech Republic
6. Name of the country from which you have arrived
7. Scan of the test results

You will receive an answer to your email from the H.S.

3.1 PRAGUE AIRPORT

- **Appointments in advance:** NO
- **Opening hours:** Monday – Sunday from 4 am to 12 am
- **Price:** CZK 1750 / 65 EUR cash and card
- **Procedure info:** The operating hours of the testing site will be adjusted according to the current air traffic. The samples taken at the airport are analysed at a remote workplace fitted for the purpose and the test results are shared with the tested person in a standard mode within a maximum of 12 hours via e-mail.

- **Procedure info:** Samples are taken at the site, analyzed and you receive results via secure email within 48 hours and an SMS with code to open your email.
- **How to get there:**
Public transport: tram stop Lazarská, No. 3, 5, 6, 9, 14, 24

3.4 SPADIA LAB, ZLUTE LAZNE

- **Procedure info:** Samples are taken at the site, analyzed and you receive results via email or SMS in 24-48 hours
- **How to get there:**
Public transport: tram stop Dvorce, No. 3, 17, 21

4. WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF QUARANTINE

In case you test positive for COVID-19, you must quarantine immediately for 14 days.

Please take the following steps:

1. INFORM LOCAL HYGIENE STATION - test results must be reported to:
covid-hc@hygpraha.cz as instructed above
2. CONTACT INSURANCE PROVIDER TO GET CONNECTED WITH A GENERAL PRACTITIONER
3. CONTACT YOUR HOUSING PROVIDER AND INFORM THEM OF THE SITUATION
4. **INFORM UNYP RECTOR'S OFFICE** at rectorsoffice@unyp.cz
5. **YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO LEAVE YOUR HOME WHEN QUARANTINED!**

When ordering deliveries, you have to inform the service provider that you are quarantined and pay by card. They will leave your shopping/food behind the door/at reception and leave without the need to interact.
