ATTENTION:

From February 22, 2021 in the Czech Republic:

It is mandatory to wear **FFP2 respirators without vents** or **other respiratory protection** of similar quality (nano-mask) in all public interior spaces (shops, services, medical and social care centers, public transport and public transport stops and stations, airports, inside vehicles etc.) and also outdoor areas where 2 or more people come in within 2 meters distance of each other (not including family members).

Cloth face masks are no longer considered as appropriate protection!

1. WHAT RESTRICTIONS APPLY TO YOU?

According to the latest measurements announced by the Czech Government and with **effect from March 1st, 2021**, all countries are divided into 5 categories based on risk of Covid-19 transmission. Every category has specific pre-arrival and after-arrival duties.

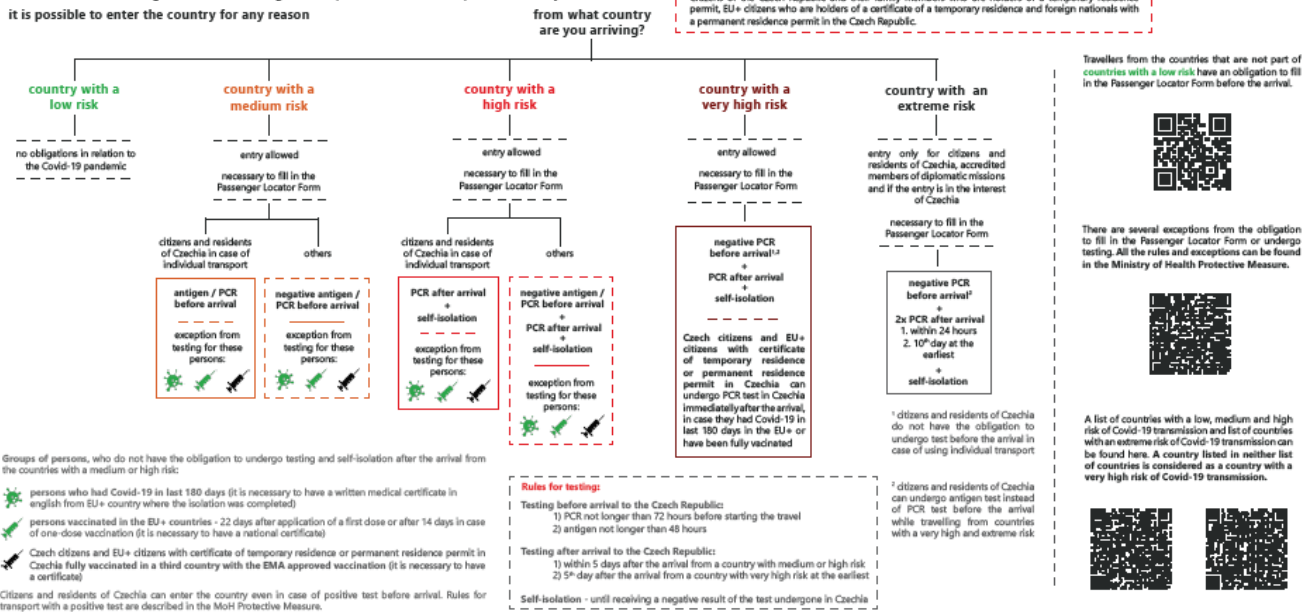
Dark Red = Very High-Risk Countries – are considered all countries that are excluded from the list above and all third countries that are not marked as green, orange, red or black

Black = Extreme-Risk Countries – travel prohibited for all except for citizens of one of the countries. Travel is possible only when essential and Czech Ministry of Foreign Affairs must be informed - Botswana, Brazil, Eswatini, India, South Africa, Colombia, Lesotho, Malawi, Mozambique, Nepal, Peru, Tanzania (including Zanzibar and Pemba), Zambia and Zimbabwe.

Rules for entry and return to the Czech Republic (as of 21st June 2021)

PART A

citizens of Czechia and foreign nationals with residence permit issued by Czechia
citizens of EU+ and foreign nationals with long-term or permanent residence permit issued by EU+
it is possible to enter the country for any reason



ATTENTION:

- Students and employees must inform their school and/or employer when travelling to any other than a green country for more than 12 hours.
- Students and employees must present a negative test result to school and/or employer on arrival to the Czech Republic from (in accordance with regulations).

2. MANDATORY PRE-ARRIVAL FORM AND TESTING FOR COVID-19

Students who spent more than 12 hours in any country other than green/low risk in the last 14 days are obliged to fill in an **online form** prior to arrival and undergo a **test** for COVID-19 prior to their arrival to the Czech Republic. Travelers from **Red, Dark Red** and **Black** countries are also required to undergo a **PCR test in CR**. In particular, they have to:

1. Fill in an **online form** <https://plf.uzis.cz/> and save the confirmation you have done so as it may be requested at border control. Mandatory for everyone expect when travelling from a **green country**.
2. Get tested **before** departure for CR and have a written confirmation of this to show at the border/Prague Airport control:

- **Orange & Red countries** - Antigen (max 48h before arrival) or RT-PCR test (max 72h before arrival)
 - **Dark Red countries** – RT-PCR test (max 72h before departure)
 - **Black countries** – RT-PCR test (max 72h before departure)
- 3. Self-isolation and a RT-PCR test after arrival to the Czech Republic:**
- **Orange & Red countries** – must undergo test within 5 days of arrival
 - **Dark Red countries** - must undergo test no sooner than 5th day after arrival
 - **Black countries** – must undergo 1st RT-PCR test within 24 hours of arrival to the Czech territory (make appointment online prior to departure), must undergo 2nd RT-PCR test no sooner than 10th day and no later than 14th day after arrival to the Czech Republic
 - Everyone has to **self-isolate and limit their movements** to obtaining essentials only – **wearing FFP2/KN95 respirator (mandatory!) when outside of your residence for 2 weeks after arrival to CR**

The RT-PCR test results will be automatically sent to your local Hygiene Station, but please inform also UNYP at rectoroffice@unyp.cz !

Who doesn't have the obligation to undergo testing and self-isolation after arrival from the **Orange & Red countries**:

- Persons who had Covid-19 in the last 180 days – it is necessary to have written medical certificate in English from EU+ country where isolation was completed
- Persons vaccinated in the EU+ countries – 22 days after application of the first dose of after 14 days in case of one-dose vaccination (it is necessary to have a national certificate)

3.1 PRAGUE AIRPORT

- **Appointments in advance:** NO
- **Opening hours:** Monday – Sunday from 4 am to 12 am
- **Price:** CZK 1750 / 65 EUR cash and card
- **Procedure info:** The operating hours of the testing site will be adjusted according to the current air traffic. The samples taken at the airport are analysed at a remote workplace fitted for the purpose and the test results are shared with the tested person in a standard mode within a maximum of 12 hours via e-mail.

- **Procedure info:** Samples are taken at the site, analyzed and you receive results via SMS within 24 hours.
- **How to get there:** Public transport: Metro stops Muzeum and Můstek

3.3 MESTSKA POLIKLINIKA PRAHA

- **Appointments in Advance:** YES
- **Opening hours:** Monday – Friday from 7:30 am to 12 pm
- **Price:** CZK 1510 only by card
- **Procedure info:** Samples are taken at the site, analyzed and you receive results via secure email within 48 hours and an SMS with code to open your email.
- **How to get there:**
Public transport: tram stop Lazarská, No. 3, 5, 6, 9, 14, 24

3.4 SPADIA LAB, ZLUTE LAZNE

- **Appointments in Advance:** NOT required, but you can book online
- **Opening hours:** Monday – Friday from 8 am to 12 :30 pm and from 12:30 pm to 4 pm
- **Price:** CZK 1300
- **Procedure info:** Samples are taken at the site, analyzed and you receive results via email or SMS in 24-48 hours
- **How to get there:**
Public transport: tram stop Dvorce, No. 3, 17, 21

4. WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF QUARANTINE

In case you test positive for COVID-19, you must quarantine immediately for 14 days.

Please take the following steps:

1. INFORM LOCAL HYGIENE STATION - test results must be reported to: covid-hc@hygpraha.cz as instructed above
2. CONTACT INSURANCE PROVIDER TO GET CONNECTED WITH A GENERAL PRACTITIONER
3. CONTACT YOUR HOUSING PROVIDER AND INFORM THEM OF THE SITUATION
4. **INFORM UNYP RECTOR'S OFFICE** at rectorsoffice@unyp.cz
5. **YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO LEAVE YOUR HOME WHEN QUARANTINED!**

When ordering deliveries, you have to inform the service provider that you are quarantined and pay by card. They will leave your shopping/food behind the door/at reception and leave without the need to interact.
